# PLAY KONNECTION LEADER GUIDE OCTOBER // OBEY // WEEK 3



## **Teaching Konnection**

When you choose to listen and obey, God promises to bless you. God's blessings help you show God's love to others. When you choose not to obey, it doesn't just get you in trouble! It hurts others: their feelings, their hearts, or their bodies. Disobeying takes away your chance to show them God's love. Each day, ask God to give you the power to obey so you can help people and show them God's love.

#### Verse

Luke 11:28 NIRV

... "Instead, blessed are those who hear God's word and obey it."

### **Point**

I obey right away.

## Hear and Obey // You'll Need

No additional materials needed.

## **Activity**

- 1. **Review** Verse and Point with the whole group.
- 2. **Read** Teaching Konnection to the whole group.
- 3. Kids sit in center of room, facing leader.

**Say:** This game is like the Verse. We're going to listen to a WORD and OBEY it in groups. Watch these four actions.

4. **Demonstrate** each "word" to the kids. **Use** other leaders to show how many people should be grouped for each action.

Word	<b>Group Size</b>	Action
Bible	Kids do this	Sit on the floor, open hands like a
	alone	book, and pretend to read.
Help	Kids make	First kid lies on the floor and their
	pairs of 2	partner holds their hand as if
		helping them up
Pray	Kids make	All three kids kneel in a circle with
	groups of 3	their hands together as if praying
Worship	Kids make	All four kids hold their hands in the
	groups of 4	air and jump continually

5. Kids practice each "word."

**Say:** When I call out a WORD, you have 30 seconds to find a group and do it, or you're out.

- 6. Call out a "word" from the list above.
- 7. Slowly **count** to 30 out loud.
- 8. Kids **make** groups and **obey** the action.
- Take out kids who don't find a group, have a group of the wrong size, or who are doing the wrong action.
- Repeat with a different "word" from the list above.

#### Talk About It

**Ask:** How does this game remind you of the Point? I had to obey right away or I was out of the game.

**Ask:** Think of a time when a parent or leader asked you to do something, but you chose to disobey. How did it make you feel? *Answers will vary.* 

**Ask:** What do you miss out on when you choose to disobey? *God's blessing, getting a chance to show God's love to others, etc.* 

Ask: How did you help others when you obeyed right away during the game? When I obeyed right away, everyone in my group got to stay in the game.

#### **Bonus**

1. Repeat game.
